

How to Access and Subscribe to the AADMM Forum

To access the AADMM forum:

- Log in to the member area.
 - Using your default browser (the browser that automatically launches when you click on a link), log into the AADMM website making sure to check "**Remember Me**" before clicking on the "**Login**" button. This will keep you logged into the AADMM website so you won't have to log in each time you go to the site. It will also enable you to click on a link in your email to a Forum post and go straight to that post without having to log in again or go through the Forum home page. **This should only be done on your personal computer, not on public access computers.**
- Go to the main [Forum page](#)
 - If you are already on the website and want to see what topics are being discussed, you can go to your **dashboard** and click on "**Forums**" to get to the Forum home page. If you would like to create a post in the Forums, you will want to go to the Forum home page, pick the board you would like to post to and click the "**Create New Topic**" button at the top of the screen.

To subscribe to the AADMM forum:

- Select a Forum of interest such as 'General Discussion'
- Click on "**Subscribe**" located in the top right corner to be notified of all new discussion topics posted to this specific Forum.
 - If you only want to subscribe and participate in a specific topic within the forum click on "**Subscribe**" located in the top right corner of that topic page.
- To be notified of all replies to a specific topic discussion, click on "**Notify me of follow-up replies via email**" at the bottom left corner of the page.
- If you wish to be notified of new posts either daily or weekly instead of one at a time, you can go to the Forum home page, click on "**Manage Profile**" on the right side of your screen, then "**Edit**" on the bottom left side of the screen. You can then scroll down and you will see an option for the '**bbPress Digest Emails**', click on "**Yes**" and you will be provided options to choose how often, and what time of day you would like the notifications.
